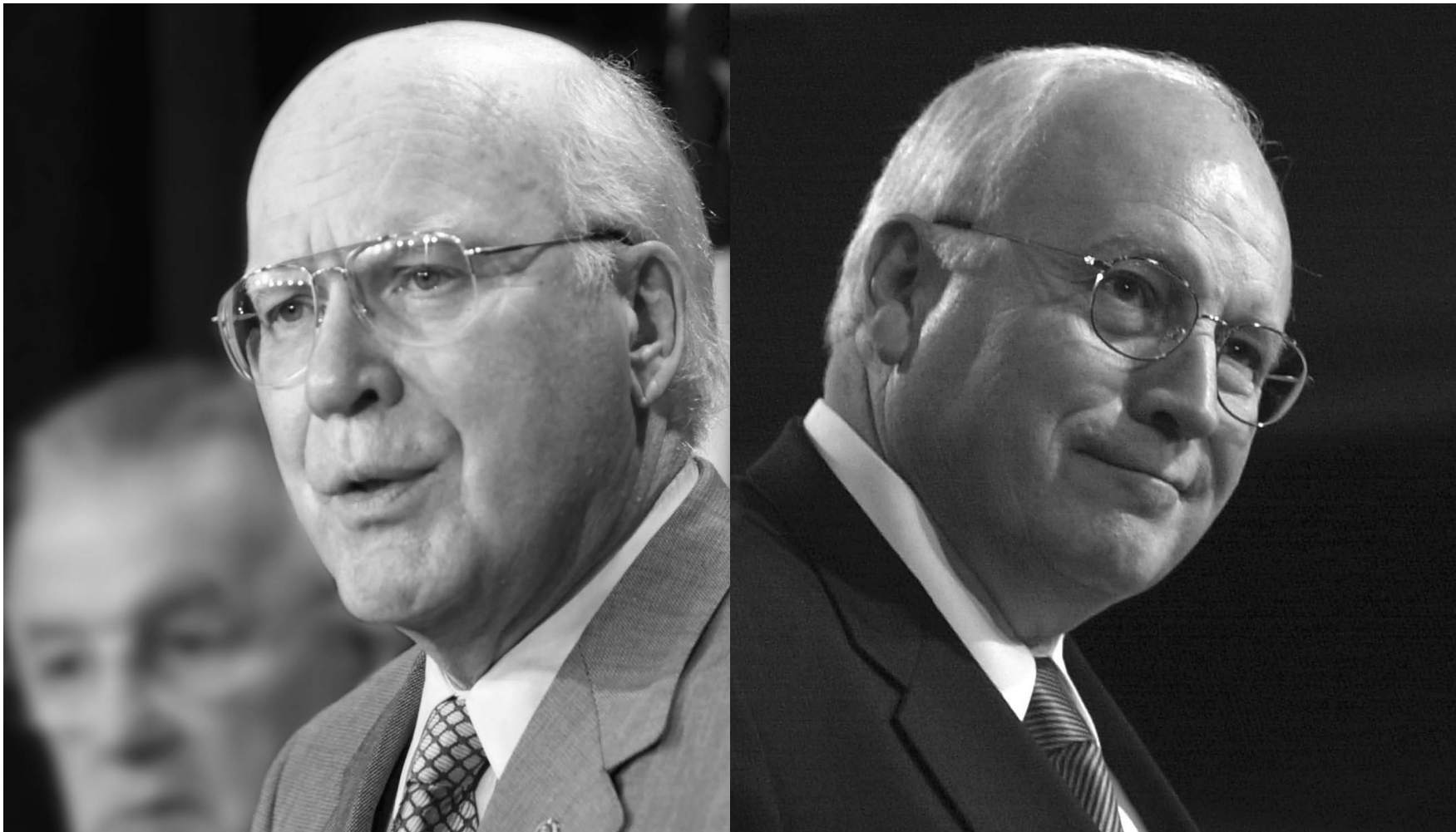


# Dick Cheney and Pat Leahy agree on something.



## Marriage should be left to the states.

During the 2000 campaign, then Vice-Presidential candidate Dick Cheney said the issue of defining marriage should be left to the states: "It's really no one else's business in terms of trying to regulate or prohibit behavior in that regard. . . . I think different states are likely to come to different conclusions, and that's appropriate. I don't think there should necessarily be a federal policy in this area."

And last month, Senator Leahy agreed: "Marriage is and always has been a State issue, and it should remain so. I fail to see how this . . . justifies a narrowing amendment being grafted onto the charter that protects the rights of all Americans — the Constitution."

Pat Leahy and Dick Cheney almost *never* agree.

This time, they're both right.
